PRINTER DRIVER INSTALLATION FOR MAC OS 10.8

Compatibility of the current OS10.5/10.6 printer drivers for Mitsubishi digital printers with OS10.8 (Mountain Lion) is being checked. This document explains how to install the printer driver to Mac OS 10.8.

When attempting to install the Mac OS X driver downloaded from web site, a message window as shown in right (Fig.1) will appear. Click "OK" button on this window and follow the steps below.

- 1) Click the installer package while holding Control key.
- 2) Click "Open" on the context menu (Fig.2).

- 3) Click "Open" button on the message windows (Fig.3).
Installation will start.

- 4) After completion of the driver installation, open "System Preferences" and select "Print & Scan".
- 5) Select the installed printer in the printer list and click "Open Print Queue..." button.
- 6) Click "Repair" button to set the access privilege for the printer driver (Fig.4).

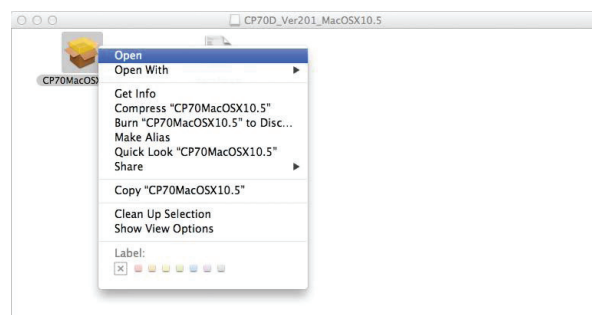

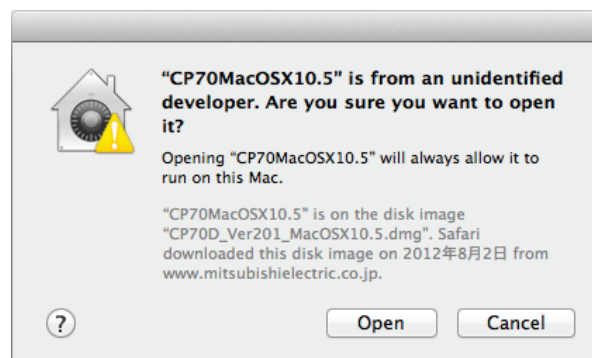

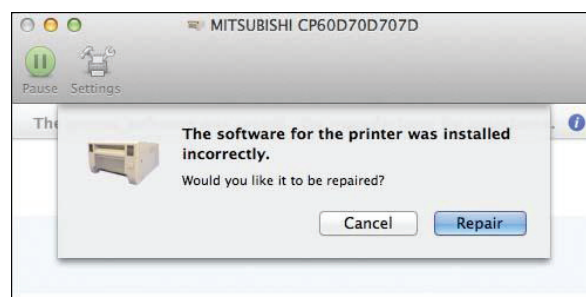
